Uniroyal RainSport 3

The Uniroyal Rainsport 3 has an asymmetrical - but **not** directional - tread pattern. For this reason the Uniroyal Rainsport 3 must be fitted with the sidewall lettering "OUTSIDE" facing outwards in order that the tyre's performance is optimized.

When the tyre is fitted on the rim in this way, then it is the right way round and can be placed on **any** wheel position on the car.



In order to minimize the driving noise, the tread grooves of the Uniroyal Rainsport 3 are not positioned horizontally, but angled. The fact that the grooves are pointing forwards on one side of the car and backwards on the other side, does not in any way affect the driving safety of the tyre on wet or dry roads.



The asymmetric tread pattern of the Uniroyal Rainsport 3 is designed to cope with the different demands placed on the outer and inner shoulders. The outer shoulder tread pattern is more closed to provide outstanding driving stability in curves and excellent steering precision. The comparatively wide tread grooves drain off or rather absorb the water volume from the wet road effectively.

The Uniroyal Rainsport 3 combines, not only because of its tread pattern, top class performance, but also a high level of safety and a striking appearance.
